

Reading film music worksheet

Score

Music (or the score) is composed carefully for a film. The composer and musicians will play the music along with the finished film so that it fits each scene perfectly.

You are going to listen to five clips of music from different film soundtracks.

On the table over the page, you will have to:

1. Give a brief description of the words that pop into your head while you're listening to the clip and/or write a brief description of what you think might be happening in the film at that point.
2. Decide the film genre you think the music fits into.
3. At the end, you'll be given the title of the film to put in the final box. (If you've figured out the name of the film anyway you can write it in beforehand!)
